

Inmate Biometric Monitoring Bid

1. Bid Purpose

Shelby County is issuing this bid in order to provide a solution for monitoring the biometric vitals of high-risk inmates

2. Requirements

2.1. Product should be capable of monitoring inmate biometric vitals.

2.1.1. Product must be capable of alerting staff in the event of abnormal/critical vital activity including but not limited to heart rate, SpO2, temperature, loss of communication with the device, or tampering with the device.

2.1.2. Product must be wrist worn and capable of displaying inmate location.

2.1.3. Product should have staff dashboard to monitor in real time all or a sub-set of deployed monitors.

2.1.4. Product should notify/alert staff when thresholds of medical norms are exceeded.

2.1.5. Bidder must provide ongoing support for solution.

2.1.6. Bidder must be provide network requirements with protocols and ports utilized for proper function of equipment.

2.2. Bid pricing is to be established as a ceiling price. At no time may the bid products be offered pursuant to this bid at prices above this ceiling price without approval by County.

2.3. All products sold by the bidder must be new. Products that have a warranty period should be clearly identified in the bid with warranty duration.

2.4. The vendor agrees that full refund, credit, or exchange will be granted to any defective-on arrival (DOA) merchandise, if reported within thirty (30) days of receipt of the order.

3. Bid Submission

3.1. County reserves the right to purchase none, one, or several of any items quoted based upon the bid unit prices.

3.2. Bidder must submit no less than (3) three references from current clients. The County reserves the right to use itself as a reference and to solicit references from clients other than those listed.

3.3. The bid proposal submitted by the most responsive vendor together with the representations made by the vendor shall be incorporated into a master technology agreement between Shelby County and the most responsive vendor.

3.4. Submitted pricing should include the form below and clearly state all one-time and reoccurring costs.
