

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-02-23-07

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Commission resolved (Resolution 2024-01-22-04) to partner with the City of Chelsea to replace the bridge (BIN 010825) on Liberty Road over North Fork Yellowleaf Creek (County Project Number SCP 59-959-24); and,

WHEREAS, Shelby County submitted a joint application with the City of Chelsea to the Alabama Department of Transportation for a Rebuild Alabama Grant and was awarded \$350,000.00 towards construction of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, Shelby County requested bids for the Project in accordance with Alabama Bid Law and received the following bids; and,

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Commission, by Resolution 2024-01-22-04, committed to provide construction funding for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the City passed a resolution at its' February 17, 2026 meeting authorizing award of the project to the lowest responsive bidder.

WHEREAS, consistent with Ala. Code § 39-5-1, the Shelby County Commission hereby certifies that bid awarded and contract to be entered into pursuant to this Resolution was let in compliance with Title 39 of the Code of Alabama and all other applicable provisions of the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Shelby County Commission hereby increases its' funding commitment for construction of the project by \$100,000.00 for a total of \$600,000.00.
2. The Shelby County Commission hereby awards the bid for Bridge Replacement on Liberty Road Over North Fork Yellowleaf Creek to the lowest responsive bidder, The Bridge Builders of Alabama, LLC.
