Sealed bids for OIL CHANGE SERVICES – RE-BID will be received in the office of the Chief Financial Officer, Shelby County Administration Building, 200 West College Street-Room 125, Columbiana, Alabama 35051 until **2:45 P.M., May 7, 2026**, at which time bids will be opened publicly and read.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Scope of Work is included in the attached document. Use of trade names and numbers shall be interpreted as establishing a standard of quality and shall not be construed as limiting competition. Any quantities listed in the Scope of Work or Bid Form are estimates only. The County may rely upon the quantities listed in the Bid Form for the purposes of determining the lowest responsible bidder. The County expressly does not guarantee the quantities of products or licenses, as applicable, actually purchased pursuant to an awarded bid.

At the time that this Invitation is issued, all informal communications with the County regarding this solicitation shall cease. If you have any questions concerning bid specifications, please submit all questions to Mary Horton at mhorton@shelbyal.com by no later than **12:00 P.M., April 28, 2026**. Responses to these questions, if appropriate, will be posted on the eBid Portal by close of business **April 30, 2026**. Bidders may only rely upon written guidance or responses. Failure to comply with this provision will be considered an improper communication and will be grounds to disqualify bidder.

All goods or services provided pursuant to this bid shall be subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws. At a minimum, the following laws shall comply:

Immigration Law. As required by Ala. Code § 31-13-9, by signing this contract, grant, or other agreement, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

Open Trade. Consistent with Ala. Code § 41-16-5, contractor by represents and agrees that it is not currently engaged in, nor will it engage in, any boycott of a person or entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which the State of Alabama can enjoy open trade.

Economic Boycott. Contractor verifies that the company, without violating controlling law or regulation, does not and will not, during the term of the contract, engage in economic boycotts as defined by Ala. Code § 41-16-160.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All bids must be sealed and marked in the lower left-hand corner **"BIDS – OIL CHANGE SERVICES – RE-BID"** with opening date and time. Bids that are prematurely opened for failure of bidder to properly mark the envelope will not be considered. Late bids will not be opened. All bids must be in writing, printed or in ink, and signed by an authorized representative. Electronic, faxed, or oral bids will not be accepted.

All bidders **must** use our form for submitting their bid. Failure to submit the bid using the format prescribed herein will be reason for disqualification of the bid. Bids will not include State Sales Tax or Federal Excise Tax. Bidder **must** submit documentation as required by the Scope of Work to evidence that bidder is qualified to perform the services herein. Bids **must** also be accompanied by the following forms certifying compliance of laws as provided above:

The County takes its responsibility under the Alabama Open Records Act very seriously. Any bids or submissions shall be considered by the Commission to be a public writing and subject to request pursuant to Ala. Code §§ 36-12-40, *et seq.* Should bidder believe that any part of its submission is exempt from public review, bidder shall submit a separate, redacted copy prominently marked as "CONFIDENTIAL," accompanied with a letter detailing each redacted section and the legal exception therefore (*e.g.*, trade secret or proprietary). For the avoidance of doubt, the Bid Form and pricing information submitted shall not be considered as confidential, trade secret, or proprietary and will be subject to public disclosure whether or not redacted by bidder. By submitting a redacted copy, bidder shall indemnify and hold harmless and fully participate in the defense of the County in response to any open records request and any and all legal claims, lawsuits, or complaints of whatever nature, including any remedies at law or equity, as well as attorney's fees costs relating to the defense or to any prevailing party, associated with the redacted portions of bidder's submission.

Bidders are to state that bids submitted are firm and that no claims for errors will be made after bids are opened and subsequent thereof.

Please provide your bid response in triplicate, one original and two copies.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS AND DISQUALIFICATION OF BIDS

The County Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities in awarding this bid to the lowest responsive bidder. Bids may be disqualified before awarding of the contract for any of the following:

1. Failure to mark envelope as required.
2. Failure to sign or notarize the bid document.
3. Failure to include requested information, samples when specified or other details of the bid.

METHOD OF AWARD


The award will be made to the lowest responsible bid meeting specifications for each item bid. It is not the policy of the Shelby County Commission to purchase on the basis of low bid only. Quality, conformity with specifications, purpose for which required, terms of delivery, and past service and experience are among the factors that may be considered in determining the responsible bid.

The Shelby County Commission reserves the right to award separate contracts for each item, each product, or any combination of products if in the best interest of the Shelby County Commission. Successful bidder will be notified of the award, and a Purchase Order will be issued by the County.

Records showing successful bidder and prices quoted will be placed on file and may be examined upon request. If contract is awarded to someone other than lowest bidder, a note of explanation will appear in the bid file and Commission Minutes.

CONTRACT PERIOD/PRICING

The period of this contract will be for **ninety (90) days** from date bid is awarded. This contract may be renewed for up to three (3) years from the initial award date upon the agreement of both parties under the same terms and conditions. Upon awarding of this contract and bid, the Shelby County Commission reserves the sole right to end said contract at their sole discretion.
