COMPACT 2020 Life Skills Curriculum

1.0) Bid Purpose

COMPACT 2020 is issuing this bid in order to provide for the training and initial material support for educator training and the implementation of a life skills training curriculum in each of Shelby County's four public school systems.

2.0) Scope/Statement of Work

COMPACT 2020 is a collaborative effort between Shelby County, the District Attorney, and the cities of Alabaster, Chelsea, Hoover, and Pelham that is designed to combat substance abuse throughout Shelby County. Prevention education strategies designed to engage impact the 5th and 6th grade age groups have been identified as a critical component for prevention of substance abuse later in life. The required components of the curriculum are defined in section 3.0. Bid responses should include pricing for initial training of up to 100 educators and applicable material costs.

3.0) Requirements

Required Features	Price
Curriculum must be research validated substance abuse prevention program	
Curriculum must address social and psychological factors that promote the initiation of substance abuse among the target age group	
Curriculum must be adaptable without sacrificing fidelity of the overall prevention model	
Curriculum must address personal self-management skills for target age group	
Curriculum must address general social skills for the target age group	
Curriculum must teach drug resistance skills	
Curriculum must be evidence based with demonstrable results based on research or implementation within other school systems	
Provider must be capable of providing training for up to 100 educators within Shelby County for implementation in Fall of 2017	
Training must be provided in support of Fall implementation NLT 30 September 2017
